Stampin' Up Supplies:

STAMPS – Latte Love Photopolymer Stamp Set

PAPER

- Early Espresso Cardstock
- Pecan Pie Cardstock
- Basic White Cardstock
- A Little Latte DSP
- Basic White Medium Envelope

INK – Early Espresso Ink and Pecan Pie Stampin' Blends

DIES – Latte Love, Deckled Circles, and Deckled Rectangles Dies

PUNCH - 1 3/4" Circle Punch

RIBBON – Peach Pie In Color 3/8" ribbon

EMBELLISHMENTS – Neutral Adhesive Backed Sequins

TOOLS – Paper Trimmer, Clear Stamp block D, Stampin' Bone Folder, Seal Adhesive, Dimensionals, Cut & Emboss Machine, Take Your Pick Tool, Paper Snips, Simply Shammy

MEASUREMENTS:

- Early Espresso 4 1/4" x 11", scored at 1 1/4" and 5 1/2"
- Basic White 4" square for inner layer, 1 1/2" square for small circle die cut, and 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" for front tag
- Pecan Pie gift card pocket 1 1/2" x 4" and 2 1/2" x 4 1/4" for 2 front mugs

- A Little Latte DSP two pieces 4" square and two pieces 1" x 4"
- A Little Latte DSP for Envelope Flap 2 ¼" x 6"

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Prepare Early Espresso Card Base, score as noted.
- Adhere 4" square piece of A Little Latte Designer Series Paper to card base front.
- Apply 3 Dimensionals to the back of Fold Back portion then affix to card front.
- Adhere both 1" x 4" A Little Latte Designer Series Paper pieces as shown in photo.
- Stamp coffee beans in Early Espresso ink on 4" square Basic White inner layer and adhere layer to inner card.
- On inner card on left side adhere 4" square piece of A Little Latte Designer Series Paper.
- Using circle punch, notch the Pecan Pie gift card piece, prior to stamping it with the coffee stains using Early Espresso ink. Stamp at full strength, then stamp off a second time.
- Flip gift card pocket over and apply Tear and Tape to the bottom and both sides as close as you can to the edges. Peel the protective layer off the Tear and Tape and affix pocket to bottom edge of the 4" square of Designer Series Paper and align the sides as well.
- Stamp the small sentiment in Early Espresso ink on the Basic White 1 1/2" square, then die cut out with the smallest Deckled Circle die. Using Stampin' Seal attach the circle to the pocket as shown in the photo.
- Stamp the front sentiment on the Basic White cardstock piece in Early Espresso ink.
- Die cut out with Deckled Rectangle die. Then reposition die 1/2" back from the right side to make the tag smaller and run through die cut machine again.
- With the remaining piece of Pecan Pie, stamp two coffee mugs with Early Espresso ink.
- Use Light Pecan Pie Stampin' Blends pen to color the inner handle and base of each mug.
- Die cut both mugs out.
- Adhere the first mug with Stampin' Seal to the left bottom edge of the tag and the card front. Use Dimensionals to raise up the second mug and position it partially on top of the left mug.
- Attach 3 dark brown sequins as shown on the tag.
- Adhere and trim the Designer Series Paper for the Basic White Envelope to match.
