

## You're the Sweetest Vertical Triple Z Fold Card

### Stampin' Up Supplies:

**STAMPS** – Filled with Sweetness (March 2026 Online Exclusive)

#### PAPER

- Basic White Cardstock
- Misty Moonlight Cardstock
- Crushed Curry Cardstock
- Homemade Sweetness Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- Basic White Medium Envelope

**INK** – Strawberry Slush

**DIES** – Filled with Sweetness Dies

**EMBELLISHMENTS** – Strawberries and Dots

**TOOLS** – Paper Trimmer, Clear Stamp block D, Stampin' Bone Folder, Seal Adhesive, Dimensionals, Cut & Emboss Machine, Take Your Pick Tool, Paper Snips, Simply Shabby.

### MEASUREMENTS by the Layers:

- **Back Base Layer** – Basic White cardstock, cut 5 ½" x 8 ½", scored at 2 1/8" and 4 ¼"
  - Homemade Sweetness DSP (Diagonal Gingham pattern in Misty Moonlight)
    - Front Panel 2" x 5 3/8"
    - Middle Panel 2" x 5 3/8"
    - Back Panel 4 1/8" x 5 3/8"
- **Middle Base Layer** – Basic White cardstock, cut 4 ½" x 7 ½", scored at 2 1/8" and 4 ¼"
  - Homemade Sweetness DSP (Mottled solid pattern in Misty Moonlight)

- Front Panel 2" x 4 3/8"
- Middle Panel 2" x 4 3/8"
- Back Panel 3 1/8" x 4 3/8"
- **Front Base Layer** – Basic White cardstock, cut 3 1/2" x 6 1/2", scored at 2 1/8" and 4 1/4" plus an additional front panel piece of 2 1/4" x 3 1/2"
  - Homemade Sweetness DSP (Small Flowers pattern in Misty Moonlight)
    - Attached Front Panel 2 1/8" x 3 3/8"
    - Middle Panel 2" x 3 3/8"
- **Additional Pieces for Card & Envelope**
  - Crushed Curry Cardstock 1" x 3" to die cut 4 little flowers
  - Misty Moonlight Cardstock for traced tag layer 2 1/4" x 3" using the die outline
  - Basic White Cardstock for die cut tag 2 1/4" x 3"
  - Homemade Sweetness DSP fussy cut two small jam jars – strawberry preserves and blueberry jam jar
  - Homemade Sweetness DSP 2 1/4" x 6" for envelope flap

**INSTRUCTIONS: *This card is assembled in the flat view, then closed when finished.***

- On the Basic White Back Base Layer, adhere the 3 pieces of DSP (plaid gingham) with 1/16" margins.
- With the Basic White Middle Layer, it will have 1/2" margins all around from the Back Base layer. Only adhere a 1 1/2" section of the front panel and all of this back panel to the Base Back Layer. The middle section will not be attached. Check for a smooth closing of the card at this step.
- On the Basic White Middle Base Layer, adhere the 3 pieces of DSP (mottled Misty Moonlight) with 1/16" margins.
- Stamp "Thank You" in Strawberry Slush ink on the back panel of the Basic White Front Base Layer.
- Before attaching the Front Base Layer to the rest of the card, attach the Middle Panel of DSP.
- With the Basic White Front Layer, it will have 1/2" margins all around from the Middle Base layer. Only adhere a 1 1/2" section of the front panel and all of this back panel to the Middle Base Layer. The middle section will not be attached. Check for a smooth closing of the card at this step.
- On the separate front panel piece adhere the last DSP panel. Close the card completely and carefully align and adhere this extra panel to the Front Base Layer. Yes the right edge will hang over the middle panel a bit, but it will allow for the card to close correctly and give the front a finished look.
- Using the tag die, trace the outline with a pencil on the Misty Moonlight piece. Fussy cut out.
- Die cut the Basic White tag & stamp the sentiment in Strawberry Slush ink. Glue the 2 tags together.
- Using the photo as reference assemble the card front layout as shown with Dimensionals. Affix the 4 Crushed Curry Flowers and add the embellishments.
- Adhere and trim the DSP on the Basic White Envelope to match.
